Descriptions	Lysosomal Alpha-mannosidase (MAN2B1) catalyzes the hydrolysis of α -linked mannose residues in N-linked glycoprotein oligosaccharides during lysosomal glycoprotein degradation, and its functional deficiency causes alpha-mannosidosis, a lysosomal storage disorder.
