<b>Description</b>	The cytoplasmic domain of human EPHA2 was expressed as an N-terminal DYKDDDDK-tagged, biotinylated protein 49 kDa using a baculovirus expression system. Following purification with DYKDDDDK tag antibody agarose and activation with ATP, the activated protein was isolated by gel filtration.
<b>Applications</b>	For use as a positive control in EPHA2 detection assays for cancer prognosis and diagnosis.
